1. How will this impact our support of current missionaries?

This project could appear in our missions budget as a line item. These funds would serve as the basis for our financial commitment but we may decide to give more funds through specific special projects.

2. Will a committee be formed to oversee the project?

Initially the project could be overseen by the pastor and the Diaconate but it may be helpful later to form a committee to continue the oversight of the project.

3. How does the money get to the people group in Nigeria?

We have connection to an agency in Nigeria called Mission Consults. We can easily transfer funds to Nigeria through them. Pastor Jim has worked with the director of Mission Consults for several years.

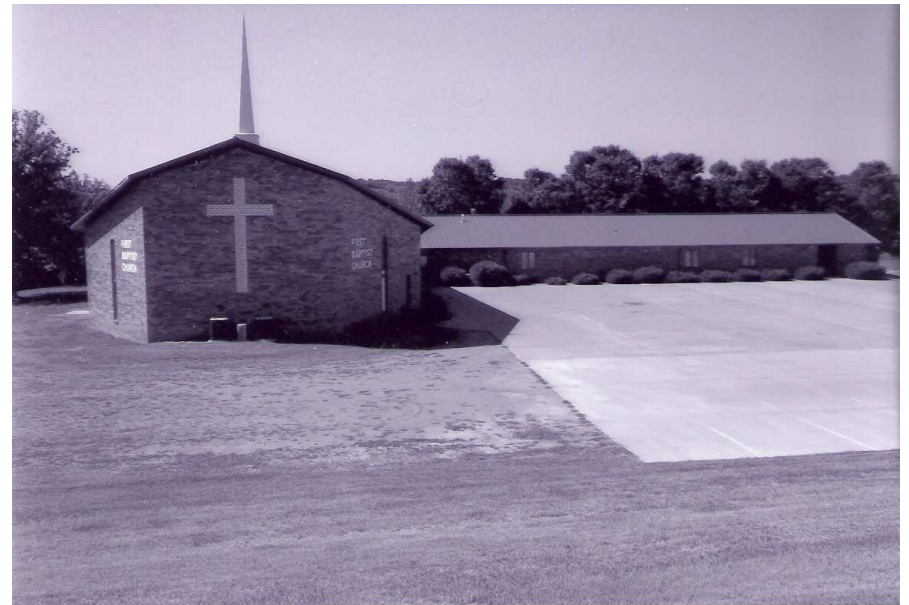
4. What kind of accountability is there that to insure that the Fulbe leaders are spending the funds how we want them to?
