Questions and answers about adopting a people group

1. Why don't we just send money to them?

We are not after just sending money. We are about building a partnership based on relationships. There is a big difference between sending money and becoming partners in a great adventure.

2. How does this impact current things like the Dorcas Circle sending linens to White Cross?

The Dorcas Circle are free to continue their ministry through the White Cross which sends relief supplies to Cameroon and Nigeria through the NAB. They might choose to sew some items for our Fulbe friends also but our partnership with the Fulbe should not affect what the Dorcas Circle is doing now.

3. Can't we do some kind of adopt a child program?

There are some great adopt-a child programs out there that we could get involved with. The advantage of this mission strategy is that we will get to know whole families and individuals and be able to partner with them in many ways as the Lord leads us.

4. How much are we expected to give?

We will start with a line item budget approximately equal to our support of a missionary family. Above and beyond that commitment, there will be opportunities to give toward specific short term projects.

5. How do we justify spending money on airfare to go to Nigeria rather than just sending money to the Fulbe?

Going on a mission trip has a three-fold impact. It impacts the person going on the trip, those who receive the person and share in ministry with them, and it also impacts the church when they come back with the fresh experience of serving in another culture. This impact is difficult to valuate in terms of dollars spent.

Our mission is to follow Jesus Christ by worshiping God, loving people, and making disciples, all for the glory of God.
