Questions and answers about adopting a people group

1. What kind of projects can be planned?

This will be spelled out in our partnership with the Fulbe but some ideas we have already thought about are educational partnerships (i.e. providing funds for education), providing funds for and assistance with evangelism, assisting with funds and or advice regarding community development projects, giving advice and support for the direction of the Fulbe people group movement, and becoming loyal prayer partners.

2. What kind of contact do we have for the people group? What if our current contact goes away?

The Christian movement among the Fulbe that we are in dialogue with have a core leadership team. Pastor Jim knows these people well. If one of these leaders goes away for some reason, we have others we can work with.

3. How do we know we're making an impact?

The beauty of partnerships is that we will have to dialogue about how we are doing. We may need to fine tune our partnership as it develops.

4. What is the first step?

The next step would be to define who we are making a partnership with then write a simple partnership agreement that makes sense to both parties.

5. Why aren't we going through the NAB for this project?

The NAB does not have any missionaries working among the Fulbe. NAB encourages churches to build partnerships such as what we are talking about here.
