October 4 and 5 is the Steer Incorporated Annual Mission Conference in Bismarck. Information for this conference is on the table in the foyer

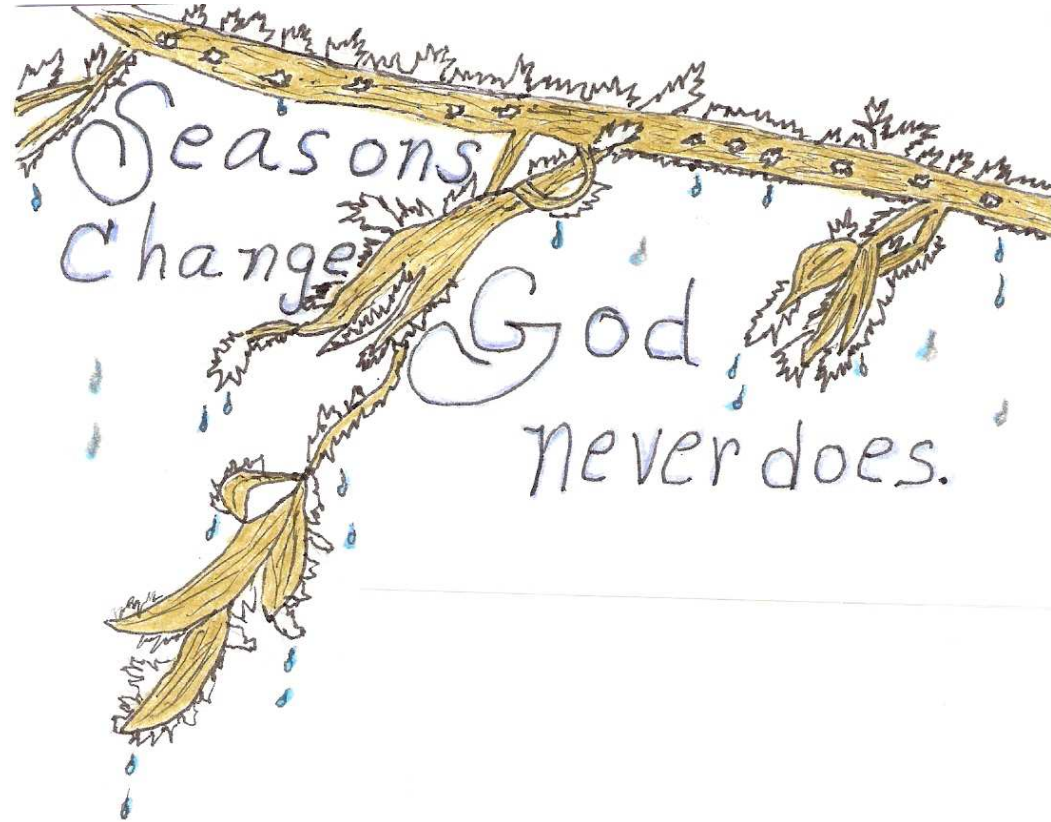
