Investment Planning!

Numbers 7

Today we are going to look at a topic that most people do not like to talk about in their home, much less in the church. It is wise investment planning. Let's consider several biblical concepts that can serve as a guide for our own personal assessment and help us when it comes to investing God's resources wisely.

1. Our "Possessions" must be at God's Disposal. (1-9)
2. Our "Example of Dedication" is more important than the amount we give. (10-88)
3. Our "Time Communicating" with God is our best asset. (89)
