The Secrets of Contentment Numbers 11

Have you ever went to the refrigerator and discovered that you only had vanilla ice cream, but you wanted chocolate?

This common occurrence is where discontentment shows up first. If we do not control it at this level, it can dominate our entire life. We can stop discontentment by following five secrets of contentment.

- 1. Instead of complaining, realize there is one who steps in the gap for you! 1-3
- 2. Instead of whining, go to the LORD with your troubles! 4-20
- 3. Instead of being overwhelmed, trust God's ability! 21-23
- 4. Instead of jealousy, appreciate people's involvement! 24-30
- 5. Instead of giving in to greed, *realize that it has dire consequences*. 31-35
