Numbers 16-17

In our society, 'talking-back,' and 'getting-even' seems to be the norm and apparently this happened also in Moses' day. **So how did Moses handle 'being-in-the-hot seat' and being opposed?** Moses had God as His authority, so he used five responses that authenticated the LORD's authority when others opposed him. We need to apply the same tactics.

1. We will humbly negotiate with those who are upset with us. 16:1-11
2. We will release our tension to the Lord when our counsel is rejected. 16:12-15
3. We will beg God for mercy when things go from bad-to-worse. 16:16-22
4. We will move back & let God handle it when things aren't resolved. 16:23-35
5. We will KNOW God's path to follow as He imparts boundaries for us to live by. 16:36-17:13
