## How do we Face Life's Known Facts with God's Certainty?

This past week, I opened the fridge door and observed that the light was out and the fridge was no longer running. I was puzzled as to what the problem was and how to repair it. Israel faced a puzzling situation also when they had to face the facts of the report the men brought back from the land of Canaan. Would they follow God's certainty or go their own way? There are five questions we need to ask ourselves in order to follow God's certainty when life puzzles us.

1. *Do we say 'we can't' or 'we can' when we know the facts?* 13:25-31
2. *Do we blame others and God or humbly honor God?* 4:1-10a
3. *Do we maintain open dialogue with God or shut Him out?* 14:10b-19
4. *Do we let God handle the outcome and do what He asks?* 14:20-39
5. *Do we operate on presumptions, or what God described?* 14:40-45
