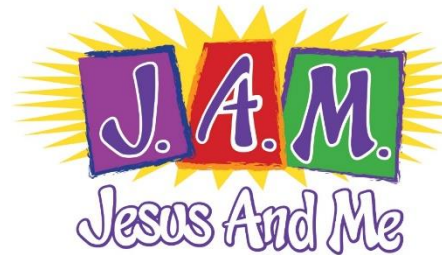

What Do You Do After You've Sinned?

Numbers 15

Have you ever tried to cover up your emotional pain and sin by putting on a 'good front' in front of others? But eventually you are found out or get caught. What happens next? How do you make things right again? There are five insights the LORD initiates in order to rekindle His relationship with us!

1. The Lord begins the restoration process by offering hope. (15:1-2)
2. The Lord urges sacrificial efforts on our part. (15:3-21)
3. The Lord forgives, but reconciliation takes two. (15:22-29)
4. The Lord disciplines those who intentionally defy Him. (15:30-31)
5. The Lord directs us in how to avoid future issues. (15:32-41)

The one who brings his offering shall present to the LORD a grain offering of a tenth of an ephah of fine flour mixed with a fourth of a hin of oil.
