Numbers 26:55b

Everyone has family members who have done things wrong, including Israel. In Numbers 26, Moses takes a second census of the Israelites, after the first generation has died, due to their disobedience. (Caleb and Joshua were the only survivors.) But God's promise was STILL intact and He wanted to make sure this new generation didn't make the same mistakes. So, as they count the families, warnings and instructions are given. Let's learn, along with the Israelites, how we can live a Godly legacy that lasts!

1. Be others-centered, even when slighted. (1-11, esp. 8-11).

Dathan & Abiram: A popularity contest between brothers, stemming from their past - Jacob.

2. Honesty that's above reproach when nobody is looking. (12- 22, esp. 19).

Er & Onan: They followed Judah's example of deceit and avoiding issues.

3. Wait on God for His answer when shame encompasses us. (23-51, esp. vs. 33).

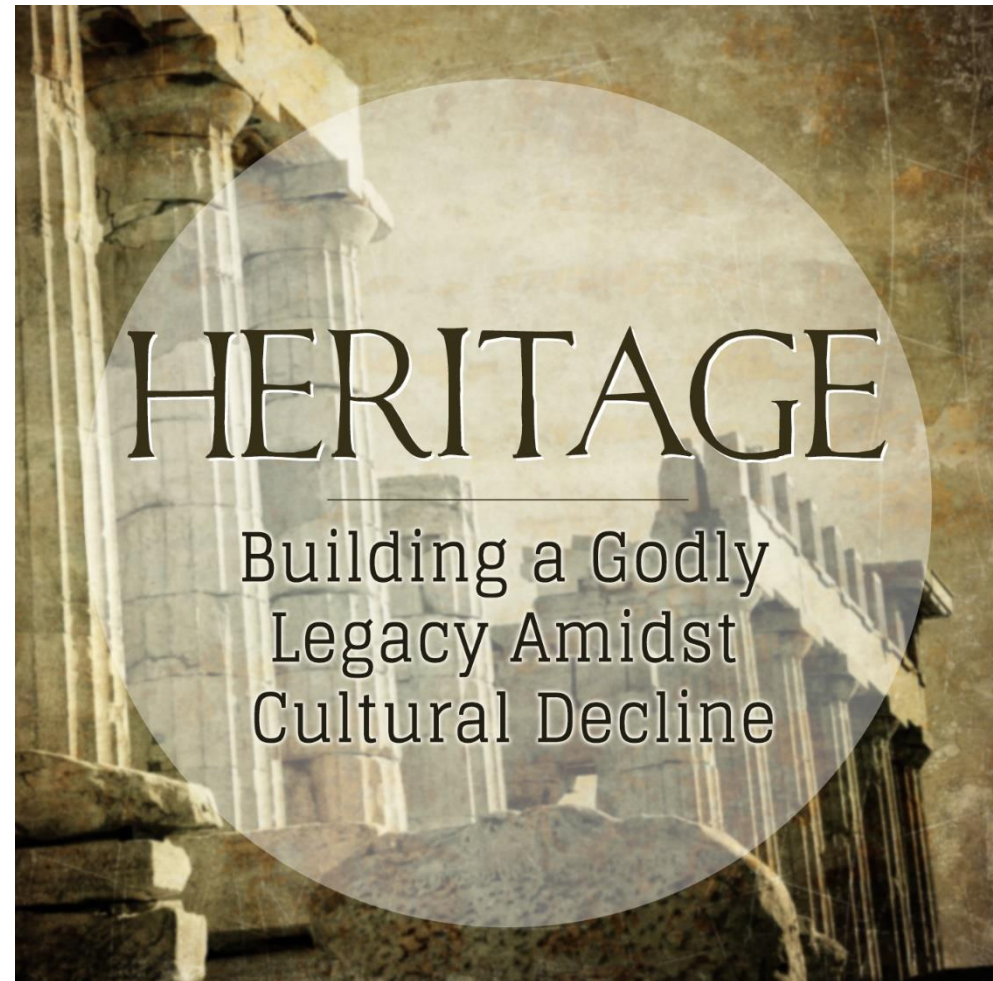
Zelophehad & No Sons: No sons in the family brought shame on the father.

4. Humbly do God's will, even when we'd rather not. (52-62, esp. 58-62).

Nadab & Abihu: They overstepped the boundaries God set up when performing sacrifices.

5. STAND-ALONE when the odds are stacked against us. (63-65)

Caleb & Joshua: They trusted in God when the others didn't.
