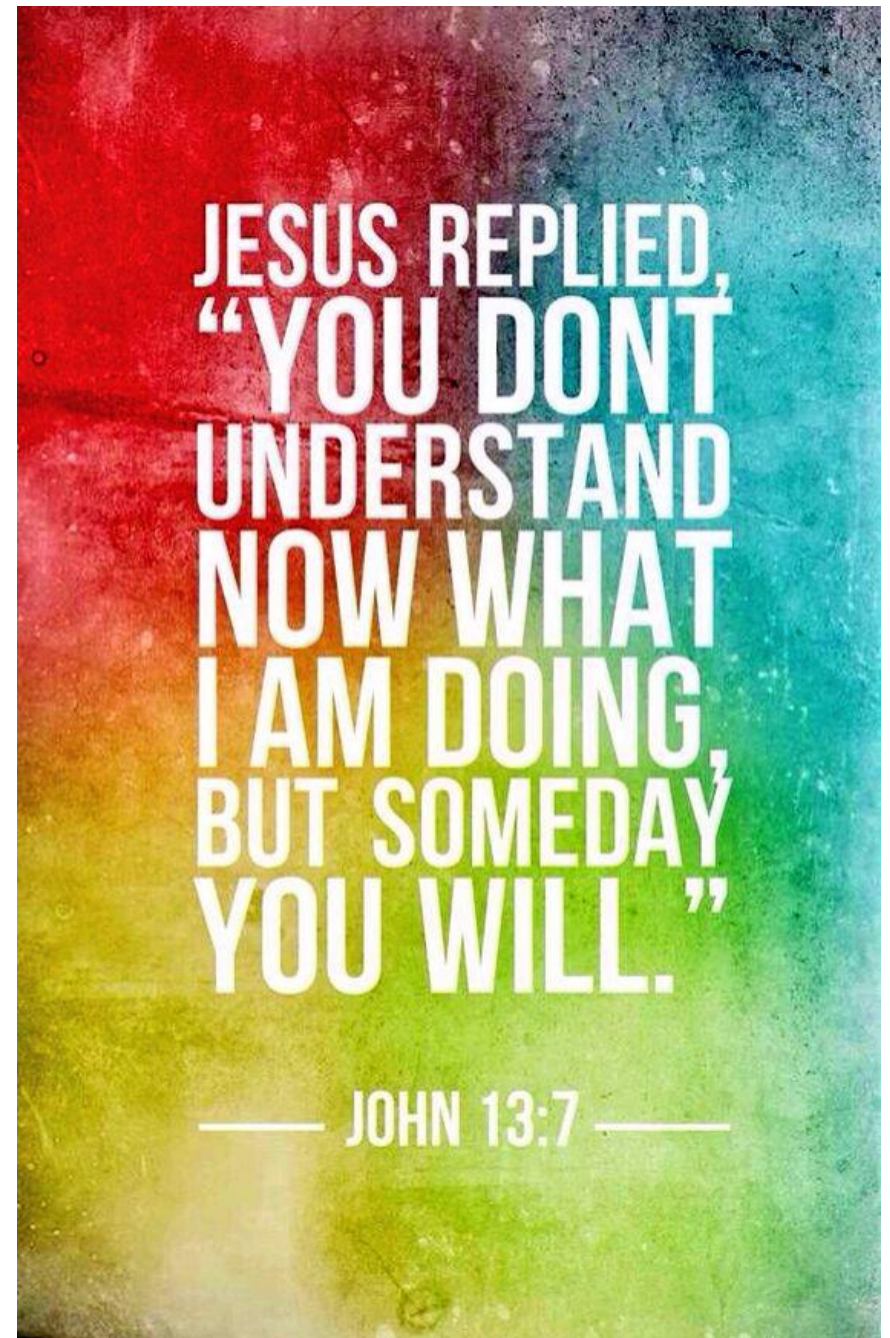
Enduring Love anticipates the uneasiness and fears that others face. (1-5)
