Acts 10:1-8

As we drive through areas of our past, we notice that the landscapes have changed. Where there once were wheat, corn or hayfields, there are now subdivisions with new houses, townhouses or apartments. On the roads, there are round-a-bouts, instead of four-way stops. We all want to see progress, but sometimes it is hard to get use to or accept.

It is also apparent that we live in a cultural that is quite different from when we grow up, when people had faith in America's founders and biblical values. But God has called us to reach out to this cultural, and our community with the gospel. So, how do we do that? We first need to discover who the people are that God has placed around us, understand how God perceives them, and then how best to minister to them.
