
## Are You Saved?

### **Paul meets with some disciples**

- I. Paul \_\_\_\_\_ in Ephesus (Acts 19:1a)
- II. Paul \_\_\_\_\_ the disciples (Acts 19:1b-4)
  - A. Question #1 - Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed? (Acts 19:1b-2a)
  - B. Answer – What Holy Spirit? (Two possible problems) (Acts 19:2b)
    1. Problem #1 – They \_\_\_\_\_ to be disciples, but they had not received the Holy Spirit.
    2. Problem #2 – We have seen throughout Acts that faith in Christ and the indwelling of the Holy Spirit occur at the \_\_\_\_\_ time
  - C. Question #2 - “Then what baptism did you receive?” (Acts 19:3a)
  - D. Answer – John’s Baptism (Acts 3b-4)
- III. Paul shares the rest of the story (\_\_\_\_\_)
- IV. Paul baptizes them in Christ (Acts 19:5)  
(The need for them to be rebaptized is that John’s baptism was for \_\_\_\_\_ in anticipation of the gospel, and they needed to be baptized as a \_\_\_\_\_ that they are now saved)
