#### **God's justice is administered to Job's Friends**

- I. Reason for God's justice towards Job
  - A. Job understood that God's ways were \_\_\_\_\_ than he could understand (Job 40:4-5)
  - B. Job repents and is \_\_\_\_\_ before God (Job 42:4-5)
- II. God's response to Job's friends (Job 42:7-9)

- III. Job's friends did as God commanded (Job 42:9)

  - B. Job obeys God and prays for them

#### **God's justice is administered to Job**

- I. God blesses Job four ways
  - A. God \_\_\_\_\_ Job's possessions (Job 42:10b, 12)  
(We must not always expect \_\_\_\_\_ blessing from God, but He will spiritually bless us)
  - B. Job's \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ return (Job 42:11)
  - C. God gives Job \_\_\_\_\_ (Job 42:13-15)
