### **God is Holy**

- I. Holy means “to \_\_\_\_\_”

### **The seraphim declare the holiness of God (Isa. 6:3-4)**

### **God calls Israel to be holy (Lev. 20:7-8)**

<sup>7</sup> “‘Consecrate yourselves and be holy, because I am the LORD your God. <sup>8</sup> Keep my decrees and follow them. I am the LORD, who makes you holy.
