#### **The unfaithfulness and punishment of Israel (Judges 10:6-18)**

- I. The people fall into sin (Judges 10:6a)
- II. God disciplines the people (Judges 10:6b-9)

#### **The people cry out for help (Judges 10:10-18)**

- I. Israel \_\_\_\_\_ (Judges 10:10)

### God raises up deliverers (Ch. 11)

- III. Jephthah makes a vow with God (Judges 11:29-31)
  - A. With God's help, Jephthah rally's Israel for battle (Judges 11:29)
  - B. Jephthah make a deal with God
    1. If God grants me \_\_\_\_\_, I will \_\_\_\_\_ the first thing that greets me when I return home
    2. Though intended as an act of \_\_\_\_\_, it showed a lack of \_\_\_\_\_ in God's enabling power
- IV. God, through Jephthah, \_\_\_\_\_ Israel from the enemy (Judges 11:32-33)
- V. Jephthah \_\_\_\_\_ his vow to God (Judges 11:34-40)
  - A. Jephthah is greeted by his \_\_\_\_\_ (Judges 11:34-35)
  - B. Response of the daughter (Judges 11:36-37)
    1. She \_\_\_\_\_ that her dad keep his promise to God
    2. She asked for time to \_\_\_\_\_ with her friends
  - C. Jephthah follows through on his vow (Judge 11:39-40)  
(Two ways he may have fulfilled his vow)
    1. He commuted his daughter's fate from being a burnt sacrifice to being an \_\_\_\_\_ servant at Israel's \_\_\_\_\_ sanctuary.
    2. Jephthah's semi-pagan culture led him to sacrifice her as a \_\_\_\_\_
- VI. The land had peace for 31 years (not mentioned)  
Jephthah (6 yrs.), Ibzan (7 yrs.), Elon (10 yrs.), & Abdon (8yrs.)
