**Why do we celebrate?** (Luke 15)

- II. God \_\_\_\_\_ for us (Luke 15:4b; 8b)  
(Christ’s goal for coming to earth – \_\_\_\_\_ and  
\_\_\_\_\_ the lost)
- III. God \_\_\_\_\_ welcomes us home (Luke 15:20b-24)
- IV. God and heaven \_\_\_\_\_ when the lost are found (Luke  
15:5-7; 9-10; 22-24)
- V. God calls us to \_\_\_\_\_ with him (Luke 15:25-  
32)

**How do we celebrate?** (Matt. 5:3-12)

- I. We are “poor in spirit” (Matt. 5:3)
  - A. We realize we are \_\_\_\_\_ and cannot \_\_\_\_\_ ourselves

- IV. We “hunger and thirst for righteousness” (Matt. 5:6)
