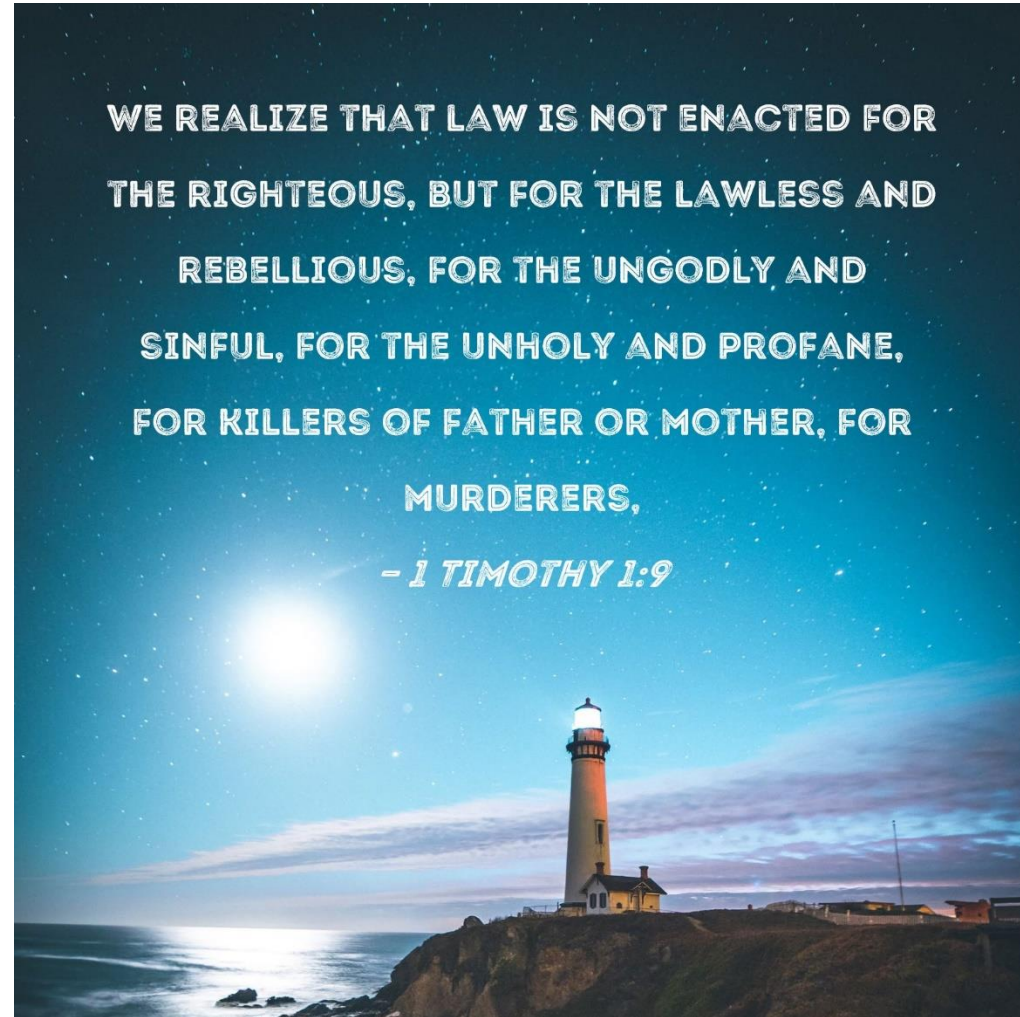
- B. Two main purposes of the law (I Timothy 1:9-11)
