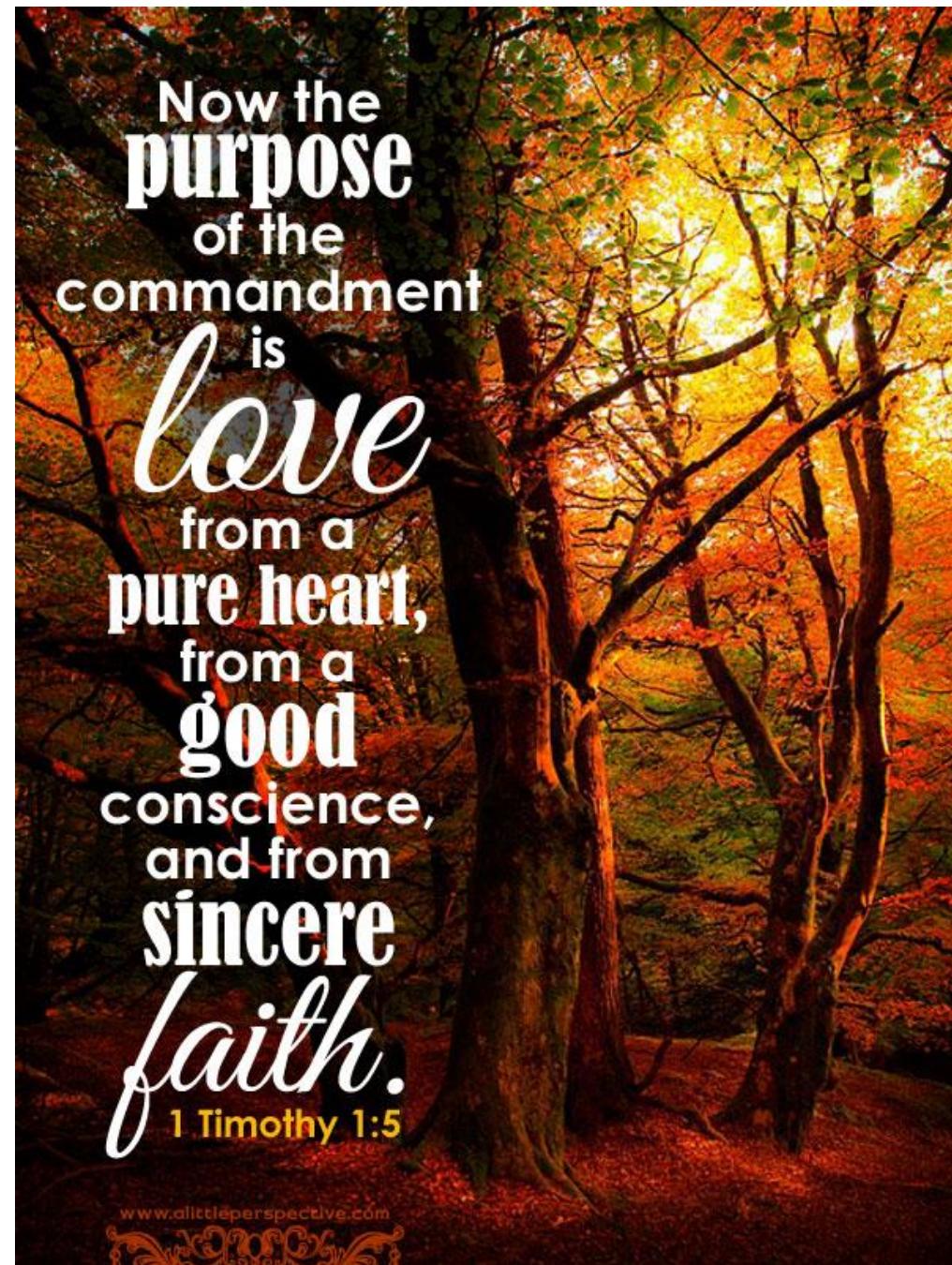

- I. Paul's \_\_\_\_\_ to Timothy (I Timothy 1:3-4a)  
(In love, \_\_\_\_\_ false teachers and bad doctrine - I Timothy 1:3a)
- II. Three problems that come from \_\_\_\_\_ (I Timothy 1:4b; 6-7)
  - A. It \_\_\_\_\_ wrong things in the name of God (I Tim 1:4b)
  - B. Our words becoming meaningless because they are not founded on \_\_\_\_\_ (I Timothy 1:6)

    2. Two main purposes of the law (I Timothy 1:9-11)
